Property Level Assessment and Taxation:

(Taxes based on a Residential Current Value Assessment of \$141,987)

The following information formed part of Champlain Township draft budget document. These figures reflect a notional tax rate using assessment information for the year 2008 along with calculations to generate the same tax dollars as were generated in 2007. The figures take into account assessment growth in each municipality. Most municipalities have not yet finalized their budget and tax rates for 2008.
